

**Georgia Department of Natural Resources, Coastal Resources Headquarters.
One Conservation Way, Brunswick, GA, 31520**

From Exit 29 Interstate 95.

1. Head west on GA-25 S/GA-520 W/US-17 S/US-82 W/New Jesup Hwy toward Brunswick for about 8.1 m
2. You'll cross over the very large Sidney Lanier Bridge.
3. Immediately at the foot of the bridge, turn left (at the warehouses) and follow the road back under the bridge. The road has a sign for "Coastal Resources Division Headquarters of GA DNR" and the US Coast Guard Station Brunswick. DNR is the 3-story building straight ahead in the parking lot.

From Exit 36, Interstate 95 (total 8.3 miles)

1. Take GA-27 E/US-25 S/US-341 S towards downtown Brunswick (5.3 miles)
2. Turn left at Gloucester St/State Route 25 Connector go about 1 mile
3. Turn right at light onto Glynn Ave (Hwy 17 S) go 1.8 miles
4. At the foot of the Sidney Lanier Bridge turn right (at the warehouses) onto Conservation Way and follow the road back under the bridge. The road has a sign for "Coastal Resources Division Headquarters of GA DNR" and the US Coast Guard Station Brunswick. DNR is the 3-story building straight ahead in the parking lot.

From Exit 38, Interstate 95 (total 8.6 miles)

1. Head south on GA-25 Spur S/Golden Isles Pkwy/Golden Isles Veteran Memorial Pkwy for 4.4 miles
2. Veer right onto GA-25 S/US-17 S/Glynn Ave for 3.9 miles
3. Follow Step 4 from Exit 36 above.

From Jekyll Island (total 8.6 miles)

1. Head back across GA-520 W/Ben Fortson Pkwy/Jekyll Island Causeway towards Brunswick
2. Turn right at GA-25 N/US-17 N/Ocean Hwy. Cross over large Sidney Lanier Bridge.
3. Follow Step 3 from Exit 29 above.

From St. Simons Island (8.9 miles)

1. Get on F J Torras Causeway to leave the island
2. Turn left at Glynn Ave/US 17 S. Travel 2.4 miles.
3. Follow Step 4 from Exit 36 above.
